

FESTIVAL RULES FOR your enjoyment & SAFETY

Bags will be searched upon entry. Use amnesty bins for prohibited items.

DRUGS

No drugs or paraphernalia except for medical purposes.

Use the amnesty bin.

SMOKING

Only in designated areas.

KNIVES AND BLADES

No knives or blades. Use the amnesty bin.

AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIOUR

Aggressive or antisocial behaviour will result in removal and no re-entry.

NO BALL GAMES

Outdoor ball games are not allowed.

NO DOGS

Only assistance dogs with appropriate jackets.

NO GLASS

No glass containers on site.

NO FOOD

No food allowed. For severe allergies, ask Team Test Fest.

PHOTOGRAPHY

The event will be recorded and photographed.

Attendance implies consent for future use.

LOST & FOUND CHILDREN

Found Children located in the It's in the Bag Tent.

Lost Children to be reported to Security

Children will have a special wristband with a contact number tag.

NEW MOTHERS & PERSONAL NEEDS

Private breastfeeding areas available.

Emergency period products and mild analgesia provided.

CASH

No ATMs on site.

Some vendors accept cards, others are cash only.

TICKET RULES

Programming is subject to change without notice.

Performers and line-up are subject to change without notice

DO NOT tamper, stretch, cut or alter your wristband in any way.

Wristbands cannot be shared

Officially, re-entry is not allowed, but individual cases may be considered.
It's in the Bag is not responsible for loss or damage to individuals, personal property, or vehicles. **NO ENTRY AFTER 7.30PM**

CAMPING

Camping is available from 18.00 on Friday 19th June 2025

ARRIVAL INSTRUCTIONS:

On arrival please DO NOT go to the camping field

Drive straight to the Main Ground Car Park to be checked in and given your wristbands.

Once checked in you will be given your camping pitch number where all the pitches have been marked out and numbered.

You will be the first to have an opportunity to get a (New to Test Fest) Programme with line-up times and what's available.

Everyone is required to wear a wristband for the duration of the festival.

DEPARTURE INSTRUCTIONS

All campers must vacate the site by 11am on Sunday 21st June.

FRIDAY ENTERTAINMENT

There will be a bar, food and Entertainment available on Friday evening at 8pm – 10pm.

FACILITIES

Camping includes toilets, bins, hand wash station and access to water

There are no showering or washing up facilities.

Camper vans and motor homes permitted **NO CARAVANS.**

NO DOGS ALLOWED

Apart from assistance dogs with the appropriate jacket.

FOOD

You are permitted to bring food and drink into the camping area for your personal consumption on your pitch.

NO food or drink to be brought into the arena from your pitch.

If you are found to bring alcohol into the arena it will be confiscated.

PITCH RULES

Maximum of 6 people per pitch

Campers cars to be parked within the confines of your pitch.

All vehicles are the responsibility of the owner

Strictly no open fires or campfires in the campsite, except for small rocket stoves or other small devices used for cooking purposes only.

Barbeques are NOT permitted on site in the camping areas.
